This is an application by the Orange County Department of Social Services to suspend unsupervised visitation between Respondent Miriam Teitelbaum and the subject children. The application was brought on by way of Notice of Motion returnable in this Court on September 22, 2011. The Respondent Miriam Teitelbaum, through her attorney, Maria A. Patrizio, Esq., of counsel to the Legal Aid Society of Orange County, Inc., filed an Affirmation in Opposition. On the return date Stephanie Bazile, Esq., Assistant County Attorney, appeared on behalf of the Orange County Department of Social Services; Kim Pavlovic, Esq., of counsel to the Children's Rights Society, Attorney for the Children, appeared; and Maria A. Patrizio, Esq., of counsel to the Legal Aid Society of Orange County, Inc., appeared. The motion was marked fully submitted


for written decision.

In reviewing the allegations contained in the Affidavit of Kathleen Gechern, sworn to on September 14, 2011, it appears to ensure the safety of the subject children that the order of unsupervised visitation in the Respondent mother's home must be modified. The allegations specify a course of [REDACTED] which resulted in the Respondent mother being hospitalized in the [REDACTED] al. The Respondent mother does have a [REDACTED] history with prior hospitalizations. Accordingly, the Court will modify the Permanency Hearing Order dated August 2, 2011, and require that the Department of Social Services supervise the weekly two hour visitation period in the Respondent mother's home pending further review by this Court. This will occur when the Respondent mother is released from the hospital. This is in addition to the one and one-half hour supervised visitation the Department is required to provide under said order.

This constitutes the decision and order of the Court.


